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AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION
UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and ELMER NEUFELD, ESQUIRE, Applicant,

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Elmer Neufeld, Esquire, filed a proposal with the department in connection with the operation of a plant for the recovery and recycling of industrial solvents to be located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 31, Township 9, Range 4 EPM in the Rural Municipality of Ritchot, Manitoba;

AND WHEREAS in the absence of limits, terms and conditions prescribed by a regulation under the said Act, the proposal was referred to The Clean Environment Commission to prescribe limits, terms and conditions;

AND WHEREAS the Commission received notice of representation from a person who was likely to be affected by an order issued by the Commission in connection with the said operation;

AND WHEREAS the Commission held a hearing in Winnipeg on the 24th day of January, 1983;

AND WHEREAS the Commission considered the proposal on the 24th day of January, 1983;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT


1. Subject to 2, the Applicant shall not at any time cause or permit the emission or discharge of vapours, solvents, or wastes to the environment from the said operation.
2. The Applicant shall:
 - (a) dispose of all wastes from the said operation to a waste disposal ground registered pursuant to a regulation issued under the said Act unless an alternative method of disposal is authorized by the Environmental Management Division;
 - (b) transport all products, by-products and wastes from the said operation in closed containers in such a manner as to prevent the spilling or wind entrainment of the said products, by-products or wastes.

3. The Applicant shall not process any type of solvent chemical in the said plant unless he first submits a description of the nature, source, and estimated quantities of the said solvent chemical to the Environmental Management Division.
4. The Applicant shall design and construct the storage and operation areas of the said plant in such a manner as to prevent spilled liquids from entering the soil or any sewer.
5. The Applicant shall, at all times, maintain a high standard of equipment maintenance, good housekeeping, and operation in such a manner as to comply with the limits, terms and conditions prescribed in this order.
