**Consultation on Proposed Amendments to the  
Hazardous Waste Regulations**

Manitoba Conservation is considering amendments to the *Generator Registration and Carrier Licencing Regulation* (MR 175/87), the *Manifest Regulation* (MR 139/88) and the *Classification Criteria for Products, Substances and Organisms Regulation* (MR 282/87) pursuant to *The Dangerous Goods Handling and Transportation Act*.

The main intent of the proposed amendments is to update the system of identifying hazardous wastes to be consistent with industry needs and federal regulatory requirements and to reduce paperwork requirements while still maintaining Conservation's ability to track hazardous waste shipments and identify potential issues.

Representatives of your company are invited to attend a consultation session with other industry stakeholders to review and provide comments on the proposed amendments. This consultation will be held from 9:30 am to 11:30 am on Thursday, January 28<sup>th</sup>, 2010, at Holiday Inn Airport West, 2520 Portage Avenue, Winnipeg.
