## Re: Malteurop Canada Ltd – Notice of Alteration

Thank you for the Notice of Alteration (NoA) dated April 1, 2015 in which you requested an approval to replace two of the existing heaters and heat exchanger units at the Winnipeg Malteurop Canada malt manufacturing plant. It is understood that the proposed alteration uses less energy due to a higher efficiency of the heating system with improved heat recovery. In addition you have indicated that there will be no change to the overall volume of air flow.

Upon review of your alteration request, I have concluded that the environmental effects of the NoA will be insignificant, and therefore in accordance with Section 14(2) of *The Environment Act* you are hereby authorized to carry out the proposed alteration as described in the April 1, 2015 NoA. This approval is conditional on the decommissioning of the existing heating system. Please submit a decommissioning plan before the installation of the heating system.
