

Notice of Environment Act Proposal

Manitoba Sustainable Development has received a proposal pursuant to The Environment Act regarding the following operation and invites public participation in the review process:

THE TOWN OF THE PAS - WASTEWATER TREATMENT LAGOON – FILE: 144.40

An Environment Act Proposal was filed on behalf of The Town of The Pas for construction of six Submerged Attached Growth Reactor (SAGR) cells, an aeration building, a baffle curtain in the existing lagoon cell, an alum dosing system, and accommodation for a UV disinfection system. The accumulated biosolids generated from the existing wastewater treatment lagoon located on NW 2-56-26 WPM will be land applied. The treated effluent will be continuously discharged into Grace Lake.
