Conditional Approval

This EAP has been given clearance at this time as there are no further plans for developments which will cause ground disturbance. However, if future developments are planned in which construction activities may impact the landscape or cause ground disturbances, the Historic Resources Branch is requesting that <u>prior</u> notification is given so that any possible impacts to heritage resources can be determined and mitigated as necessary.

If at any time, however, heritage resources are encountered in association with these lands the Historic Resources Branch may require that an acceptable heritage resource management strategy be implemented by the developer to mitigate the effects of development on the heritage resources.

While the potential to impact significant heritage resources was deemed by Boeing to be low, by reason that the plant is located in an established industrial zone (Section 5.3, page 14), a burial mound has been identified on the Murray Park property (as per Appendix G, page 92). The Historic Resources Branch, therefore, must be immediately contacted if heritage materials are encountered during development.

Future EAPs must include the provision concerning the possibility of encountering heritage sites, and contain a plan outlining appropriate measures to mitigate those impacts upon such an encounter.
