Environment and Climate Change acknowledges the submission of the 2025 CSO Annual Report dated March 31, 2026.

Upon review, the Department has identified the following questions and requests for clarification:

- Provide further detail on the methodology used to determine the estimated 1 m³ of runoff per single small-scale development approval. Are there additional assumptions, variables, or parameters considered when calculating the total runoff associated with new developments?
- Can you provide an estimate of the anticipated increase in capture rates that is expected to result from the planned future sewer separation projects?
- Where available, please provide updated projected completion dates for the ongoing projects that were originally anticipated to have been completed by this time, along with a brief explanation of any significant delays.
