Discharge of St. Laurent Wastewater Treatment Lagoon

This letter acknowledges the request made by the Rural Municipality of St. Laurent on October 6, 2017 to commence discharge of effluent from the secondary cell of the St. Laurent - Oak Point Wastewater Treatment Lagoon without meeting the effluent limit for total coliforms as specified in Environment Act Licence 1529.

I am granting a suspension of Clause 2(c) of Environment Act Licence No. 1529 pursuant to Section 18(1) of The Environment Act which allows you to proceed with the discharge. The suspension is in effect from October 16, 2017 to October 27, 2017 inclusive for this event.

All other clauses in Environment Act Licence No. 1529 remain in effect.
