Hello Donna

The plan will be to address all of these in compliance with TAC. Our plan is...

1. Nutrien AG Solutions will work with Machibroda to address items 1 & 2. I believe these two are the connected and we will work with Machibroda to help us set up, as well as lean on a couple of internal folks that have experience with this type of monitoring.
 1. **I would ask that we are allowed to complete the project and then have a company on site to drill the additional holes, that way we do not disturb the monitoring areas during construction.**
2. On site Retail team will review any changes during their next ER Plan update. I do not see any major changes required, but when we update the ER Plan it will need to include the new tank system. Our local SH&E advisor will work with the team to ensure changes are made upon completion. This will include updated drawings of the site, including the Engineered Drawings provided by KPIC.
3. Update wording on the ER Plan, to contact surrounding residents, in the event of a spill that could leach, no different than a release in NH3 and wind direction.

May I request that we are allowed until the completion of the project before we finalize these action items. We are going to be dealing with some weather now, and to drill holes following the completion, I would like to wait till spring thaw.
