

## Notice of Environment Act Proposal

Manitoba Sustainable Development has received a proposal pursuant to *The Environment Act* regarding the following operation and invites public participation in the review process:

### **CROP PRODUCTION SERVICES (CANADA) INC. – FORK RIVER SEED TREATMENT FACILITY - FILE: 3845.10**

A proposal has been filed by Crop Production Services (Canada) Inc. for the construction of a seed treatment facility at the existing crop protection products, anhydrous ammonia and granular fertilizer site located on SW ¼ 1-30-19 WPM in the Rural Municipality of Mossey River. The seed treatment aspects of the Development will include a 30 tonne/hour seed treater/continuous batch blender, six 135 tonne hopper bottom bins, one 50 tonne hopper bottom bin, and a 4.6 by 22.9 meter Batco tubeveyor. The hopper bins will be placed on a 4.9 by 6.0 meter concrete outload pad.
