Re: Environment Act Licence No. 2191 E

We have reviewed your letter dated September 13, 2010 requesting an extension of the expiry date of Environment Act Licence 2191 E to December 31, 2011. It is understood that this extension is necessary to complete discussions between the Department and Louisiana-Pacific concerning LP's 20-year Forest Management Plan, and the licensing requirements of the Environmental Assessment and Licensing Branch.

The Environmental Assessment and Licensing Branch is processing this request as a minor alteration to Environment Act Licence No. 2191 E, pursuant to clause 14(2)(b) of The Environment Act. Given the circumstances, I hereby approve the extension of the expiration date of Environment Act Licence No. 2191 E to December 31, 2011, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. A valid Annual Operating Plan must be maintained for FML #3;
- 2. All specifications, limits, terms and conditions identified in Environment Act Licence No. 2191 E shall be strictly adhered to; and
- Any additional specifications, limits, terms and conditions that may be identified by the Director of Forestry Branch and the Regional Integrated Resource Management Team of Manitoba Conservation shall be strictly adhered to.
