**Re: New Flyer Industries Canada ULC - Environment Act Licence No. 2528 E RR
- Notice of Alteration Approval**

Thank you for your notice of alteration submitted March 18, 2025. The department understands you wish to expand operations to a leased warehouse at 630 Kernaghan Avenue, Winnipeg. The expansion will accommodate final assembly and completion of diesel, electric and hydrogen fuel cell buses.

The final assembly processes will include the following:

- installation of engine and drive train components
- interior finish items such as seats and interior lighting
- an 80-foot long paint booth for painting
- installation of fueling/charging stations including hydrogen fueling station
- installation of a 3500 liter above ground diesel fuel storage tank with pump.

I approve the alteration per Section 14(2) of The Environment Act with the following conditions:

- Submission of final site plan and building plan pursuant to clause 9 of the licence within 60 days of commissioning of the expanded operations.
- Submission of a roof plan with the building plan showing the location of stack/s at 630 Kernaghan Avenue.
- Submission of a revised floor plan showing the location of decommissioned paint booths at 711 Kernaghan Avenue.

All other clauses of Environment Act Licence No. 2528 E RR remain in effect. This approval is available on the public registry at
