## Re: ERCO WORLDWIDE - Environment Act Licence No. 2495 R6

Thank you for your notice of alteration dated March 30, 2022. You wish to make a series of amendments and alterations to multiple clauses of Environment Act Licence No. 2495 R5, specifically (1) change the soil and groundwater monitoring result reporting deadline from the current 60 days to 90 days; (2) remove TOC from soil and groundwater analyses and reduce the number of soil samples collected from 30 to 15 different locations; (3) remove clause 30 from the licence; (4) remove clause 46 b); and (5) remove clause 47.

The requested alteration per Section 14(2) of The Environment Act has been partially approved and revised Environment Act Licence No. 2495 R6 is enclosed with the following conditions:

- clause 25 is modified to include subclauses a) to f) addressing various aspects of the groundwater and soil monitoring programs
- clause 30 is retained in the licence
- clause 47 is modified to current standard wording

All licence requirements and federal, provincial, and municipal regulations and by-laws must be followed. The licensee must get approval from the director per The Environment Act to alter the development. Anyone affected by this decision may appeal, in writing, to the Minister of Environment and Climate Change at <u>minec@leg.gov.mb.ca</u> by November 25, 2023. The licence is available on the public registry at <u>https://www.gov.mb.ca/sd/eal/registries/index.html</u>.
