MANITOBA SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT, PARKS & PROTECTED SPACES - ADAM LAKE WASTEWATER LAGOON UPGRADE - TURTLE MOUNTAIN PROVINCIAL PARK – FILE: 457.10

A proposal was filed by Manitoba Sustainable Development - Parks and Protected Spaces Branch for the expansion and operation of a wastewater treatment lagoon in the Adam Lake Campground in the Turtle Mountain Provincial Park within SE 22-01-20W. The proposed expansion consists of the construction of a new clay lined secondary lagoon cell that will be located directly south of the existing wastewater treatment lagoon. Other components of the proposal consist of removal of the existing interconnecting dike between the existing two cells to create one new primary lagoon cell. Treated wastewater from the wastewater treatment lagoon will be discharged once per year between September 16th and October 31st of any year to a lowlying wetland area to the north which ultimately connects to Bower Lake.
