A proposal was filed on behalf of the Rural Municipality of Pipestone for installation of approximately 13.9 km of high density polyethylene forcemain connecting a proposed lift station within the community of Pipestone to the Reston lagoon primary cell. The lift station will be located at NE 9-7-26 WPM and the forcemain piping will be located within the following municipal road right-of-ways: NE and SE of 9-7-26 WPM; NE and NW of 4, 5, 6-7-26 WPM; NE and NW of 1, 2, 3, and 4-7-27 WPM; and NE of 5-7-27 WPM. The existing lagoon servicing the Community of Pipestone will be decommissioned.
