The **Municipality of Souris-Glenwood** is requesting an amendment to the DGHTA license to operate a full Household Hazardous Waste collections depot at the Transfer Station on or at NE 34-07-21W . See attached illustrated on the accompanying map.

The collection site will operate in accordance with the Product Care Association (PCA) Manitoba Household Hazardous Waste Stewardship Program and the Manitoba Product Care Collection Site Guidelines and regulations. The site will handle household hazardous waste falling into the Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act Classes 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8 and 9. As per attached checklist. The estimated quantity for each of these is included on the attached Hazardous Waste Generator Registration Form.

The collection building will be a 53ft container with a non-pours floor, locking doors and passive ventilation. All hazardous waste will be packed in TGD approved containers.
