**Re: Niverville wastewater treatment lagoon - wastewater effluent limit for phosphorus in effect January 1, 2016**

As you have been previously notified, your wastewater treatment lagoon at Niverville is required to meet the 1 mg/L phosphorus limit as of January 1, 2016 in accordance with the Water Quality Standards, Objectives and Guidelines Regulation under *The Water Protection Act*.

Your wastewater treatment lagoon for the Town of Niverville operates under Environment Act Licence 2712. In addition to meeting the 1 mg/L phosphorus limit and in accordance with Clause 2 of Licence 2712, you are hereby required to sample, analyze and report on the total phosphorus content of your wastewater effluent prior to discharging to surface water.
