Thank you for the Decommissioning Report Summary received on September 20, 2019 that notified the Department that all hazardous materials have been removed from the facility and a Phase II Environmental Site Assessment was completed.

As such, Manitoba Conservation and Climate has cancelled Dangerous Goods Handling and Transportation Act Licence 220 HW, and File 5239.00 has been closed.
