Re: Brady Road Resource Management Facility - Notice of Alteration Approval -Environment Act Licence No. 3081 R

Thank you for your notice of alteration submission dated December 7, 2021, for an alteration to Environment Act Licence No. 3081 R (Licence) originally issued for the construction and operation of the development, being a class 1 waste disposal ground and resource management facility located at 1901 Brady Road in Winnipeg, Manitoba.

The intent of the alteration is two-fold:

- to use tire derivative aggregate (TDA) as a drainage medium in the transition area between the historic waste disposal area developed prior to issuance of the Licence and Cell No. 33. The transition area is referred to as plateau area. It is proposed that the use of TDA will not extend into the footprint of the HDPE liner of Cell No. 33, and will not be applied to any HDPE lined surfaces of Cell No. 33.
- to decommission the existing temporary leachate pond that occupies the plateau area by pumping out the leachate, removing debris and the HDPE liner, and backfilling the excavation with high plastic clay.

Upon review of the notice of alteration, I am satisfied that the identified changes in the environmental effects resulting from the proposed alteration would be insignificant. Therefore, pursuant to Section 14(2) of The Environment Act, I approve the implementation of the December 7, 2021 notice of alteration with the following conditions:

1. The Licensee shall notify the assigned Environment Officer of the Environmental Approvals Branch and the Regional Supervisor of Environmental Compliance and Enforcement Branch not less than five days but not more than ten days prior to the construction initiation in accordance with Schedule B of the Waste Management Facilities Regulation.

- 2. The Licensee shall ensure that the construction of the alteration is overseen by a professional engineer. The engineer shall ensure that only suitable material is used during construction and that any unsuitable material is removed.
- 3. The Licensee shall:
 - a) prepare record drawings of the alteration, and shall label the drawings "record drawings";
 - b) submit record drawings to the Director within 120 days of the completion of the construction of the alteration.
