

Notice of Environment Act Proposal

Conservation and Water Stewardship has received a proposal pursuant to *The Environment Act* regarding the following operation and invites public participation in the review process:

RUBBER DUCKY RESORT AND CAMPGROUND LTD. - SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT –FILE: 5589.00

A proposal was filed by Rubber Ducky Resort and Campground Ltd. for the construction and operation of a wastewater collection system and a wastewater holding tank system that will service the seasonal resort and campground located in NW 26-13-1 WPM in the Rural Municipality of Woodlands. Wastewater collected and stored in the wastewater management system will be pumped out of the holding tank system and trucked by licensed haulers to the Rural Municipality of Woodlands – Warren wastewater treatment lagoon that operates under Environment Act Licence No. 1714.
