As per company mandate to reduce dust in plant operations in all facilities and plants, a new dust collector was installed on our open mouth bagging line. The unit is a Gold Series X-Flo (GSX) industrial dust collector rated at 10hp with 4 standard filters and recovery of dust into a sealed 50gallon drum. Due to the wet nature of a majority of the aggregate products that we package on this line, minimal dust is generated. The purpose of this dust collector is to minimize potential silica inhalation for our employees when occasionally packaging dustier products on this line. All dust collected from this line will be recycled back into our aggregate stock. Environmental impact is also minimal due to the fact that this line is only utilized during the 6 months of the year where freezing of aggregate in feed hoppers is not a problem. No changes have been made to increase production by this installation or increases to lengths of shifts. Please view following pictures of installed dust collector and piping:
