Re: Urbanmine Inc., Environmental Act License No. 3199R – Weekend overtime work Revoked for Saturday's for the month of September, 2021

On September 2, 2021, Conservation and Climate issued a letter permitting weekend overtime work to proceed throughout September. This approval was issued with conditions set in place to address potential concerns that were required to be met.

Conservation and Climate has received complaints related to the weekend overtime work on September 4th and September 11th, 2021. As part of the follow up on the complaints, weather data from Environment and Climate Change Canada was reviewed for those dates. The reported prevailing wind direction on September 4th was west/northwest and for September 11th was west. To comply with Condition 3 of the September 2, 2021 approval, outside work should have been restricted on these days based upon the reported wind direction.

Following the review of the noise complaints received and the indication that the conditions of the approval letter were not complied with, the approval to operate the Development on September 18th and September 25th 2021 is hereby revoked. Pursuant to Section 27 of The Environment Act, this decision may be appealed in writing to the Minister of Conservation and Climate within 30 days of the date of this letter.
