Re: Urbanmine Inc. – Request to Work Overtime on October 29, 2022 Environment Act Licence No. 3199R – Clause 41

Dear Linda Gammon:

Environment, Climate, and Parks acknowledges receipt of your email request dated October 21, 2022 to operate the above noted Development on October 29, 2022.

Pursuant to Clause 41 of Environment Act Licence No. 3199R, approval to operate the Development on a Saturday is granted subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The approval is valid solely for October 29, 2022.
- 2. Operations at the Development shall be limited to the hours between 9:00am to 3:30pm of the approval period.
- Wind direction is to be monitored and documented a minimum of hourly throughout the day. When the wind direction is between the west-southwest (SSW) and northnorthwest (NNW), 205 - 335°, all outdoor material handling operations must cease immediately.
- 4. Outdoor operations are restricted to one material handler operating one piece of equipment at all times.
- All other requirements of Licence No. 3199R remain in effect throughout the approval period.
- 6. A supervising officer shall be present at all times of operation at the Development.
- 7. Operations shall be limited to the following equipment:
- a. the ferrous Bano Slow Speed Rotary Shear
