The Northeast Regional Office of Environmental Compliance and Enforcement has the following comment on the City of Thompsons Environment Act Proposal for a Wastewater Treatment Plant:

The proposal calls for the use of Sequence Batch Reactor technology for the treatment of municipal wastewater in Thompson. It has been the experience of this office that the success of current systems using SBR technology in the Northeast region has been limited. The region recommends that the proponent be required to enter into a servicing agreement with a qualified contractor for a period of time to ensure proper operation, maintenance and performance of the system.
