

Notice of Environment Act Proposal

Conservation and Water Stewardship has received a proposal pursuant to *The Environment Act* regarding the following operation and invites public participation in the review process:

MANITOBA HYDRO – ST. VITAL TRANSMISSION COMPLEX - FILE: 5719.00

A Proposal has been filed by Manitoba Hydro for the St. Vital Transmission Complex project. The project is required to provide a reliable source of power to southern Manitoba. It includes two new 230 kV transmission lines, called Letellier and La Verendrye, which would originate from the St. Vital Station located near the intersection of Bishop Grandin and Lagimodiere Boulevards. The Letellier line (119 km) would travel through south-central Manitoba to the Letellier Station near Letellier, Manitoba. The La Verendrye line (37 km) would traverse south of Winnipeg to the La Verendrye Station located near Oak Bluff, Manitoba. Construction is planned for the fall of 2016.
