The Manitoba Floodway and East Side Road Authority has filed an Environment Act proposal, Project Description and draft Scoping Document for an all-reason road connecting Berens River First Nation and Poplar River First Nation. The Project involves construction of a new 94.1 km road from the Berens River to the southern boundary of Poplar River First Nation. The proposed all-season road includes four bridges over the Berens, Etomami, Northern Etomami and Leaf Rivers. Construction activities are anticipated to begin in 2016/2017.

Public comment is invited on the Environment Act Proposal, Project Description and Scoping Document. All comments received will be considered public and will become part of the project file. The Scoping Document will be used to form the basis of the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS). A separate notice will be published following receipt of an EIS in support of the project.
