

Notice of Environment Act Proposal

Conservation and Water Stewardship has received a proposal pursuant to *The Environment Act* regarding the following operation and invites public participation in the review process:

J.P. WIEBE LTD. IRRIGATION PROJECT – FILE: 5756.00

A proposal has been received from J.P. Wiebe Ltd. for the expansion of an irrigation operation south and east of Jackson Lake in the Municipality of North Norfolk. The project would involve the addition of approximately 130 acres of irrigation annually for a total of 400 acres annually on a landbase of 1260 acres. Land would be irrigated when potatoes were grown in the crop rotation. Water for the project would continue to be obtained from Jackson Lake.
