

Notice of Environment Act Proposal

Manitoba Sustainable Development has received a proposal pursuant to *The Environment Act* regarding the following operation and invites public participation in the review process:

GREENFIELD CONSTRUCTION LTD. - PORTABLE CONCRETE BATCH PLANT – FILE: 5830.00

A proposal has been filed on behalf of Greenfield Construction Ltd. for the installation and operation of a portable concrete batch plant at various locations throughout Manitoba. The facility manufactures ready-mix concrete for project sites close to the facility. The potential environmental effects of the development are related to wastewater, noise and dust emissions.
