for the construction and operation of the Development being a cropprotection products warehouse, bulk granular fertilizer facility, and bulk liquid fertilizer facility, to be located at Lots 8, 9, 10 and 11, Block 1, Plan 55349 in the Town of Beausejour, and a accordance with the Proposal filed under *The Environment Act* on December 5, 2016 and subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

#### DEFINITIONS

In this licence,

"accredited laboratory" near an analytical facility accredited by the Standards Council of Canada (SCC), or accredited by another accrediting agency recognized by Manitoba Conservation and Water Stewardship to be equivalent to the SCC, or be able to demonstrate, upon request, that it has the quality assurance/quality control (QA/QC) procedures in place equivalent to accreditation based on the international standard ISO/IEC 17025, or otherwise approved by the Director;

"affected area" means a geographical area, excluding the property of the Development;

- "agrichemical warehouse" means any building(s) where pest control products are stored for either commercial or retail purposes;
- "approved" means approved by the Director or assigned Environment Officer in writing;
- "ASTM" means the American Society for Testing and Materials;
- "chemical" includes, but is not limited to petroleum products, fertilizers and pest control products;

"dangerous goods" means any product, substance or organism designated in the regulations, or conforming with the criteria set out in the regulations, or in any regulation adopted in accordance with *The Dangerous Goods Handling and Transportation Act*, and includes hazardous wastes;

"Director" means an employee so designated pursuant to *The Environment Act*;

"Environment Officer" means an employee so designated pursuant to *The Environment Act*;

"HDPE" means high density polyethylene;

"LLDPE" means linear low density polyethylene;

"mil" means one-thousandth of a inch;

"noise nuisance" means an unwanted sound, in an affected area, which is unnoying, troublesome, or disagreeable to a person:

- a) residing in an affected area;
- b) working in an affected area; or
- c) present at a location in an affected area which is normally open to members of the public; if the unwanted sound
  - d) is the subject of at least 5 written complaints, eccentral by the Director in a form satisfactory to the Director and within a 90-day pariod, from 5 different persons falling within clauses a), b), or c), who do not live in the same hous hold or
  - e) is the subject of at least one written complaint, received by the Director in a form satisfactory to the Director, from a person alling within clauses a), b) or c) and the Director is of the opinion that if the noise had occurred in a more densely populated area there would have been at least 5 written complaints and red within a 90-day period, from 5 different persons who do not live in the same hearthold:

"odour nuisance" means a continuous or repeated odour, smell or aroma, in an affected area, which is offensive, obnoxious, trouble come, annoying, unpleasant or disagreeable to a person:

- a) residing in an affect d area;
- b) working in an affected area; or
- c) present at a location in an affected area which is normally open to members of the public; if the odour, smell or aroma
  - d) is the subject of at least 5 written complaints, received by the Director in a form satisfactory to the Director and within a 90-day period, from 5 different persons falling within clauses a), b), or c), who do not live in the same household; or
  - e) is the subject of at least one written complaint, received by the Director in a form satisfactory to the Director, from a person falling within clauses a), b), or c) and the Director is of the opinion that if the unwanted odour, smell of aroma had occurred in a more densely populated area there would have been at least 5 written complaints received within a 90-day period from 5 different persons who do not live in the same household;

"post-closure plan" means a plan indicating the actions to be taken for the care, maintenance, and monitoring of the Development after closure, that will prevent, mitigate, or minimize the threat to public health and the environment;

"secondary containment area" means, for an Agrichemical Warehouse (or crop protection products warehouse), an area designed and constructed to contain any liquids, including chemicals and fire water, resulting from a significant event such as a fire, and prevents the release of pollutants beyond the containment area;

"Standard Methods for the Examination of Water and Wastewater" means the most recent edition of Standard Methods for the Examination of Water and Wastewater published jointly by the American Public Health Association, the American Waterworks Association and the Water Environment Federation; and

"wastewater" means the spent or used water of a community or industry which contains dissolved and suspended matter.

#### TERMS AND CONFITM

#### Sampling and Analysis

- 1. The Licencee shall, unless otherwise specified in the Licence:
  - a) carry out all preservations and charyses in liquid samples in accordance with the methods prescribed in the most current ection of Standard Methods for the Examination of Water and Wastewater or in accordate with quivalent preservation and analytical methodologies approved by the Director;
  - b) carry out all sampling of end preservation and analyses on, soil and air samples in accordance with methodologies proved by the Director;
    c) have all analytical determinations undertaken by an accredited laboratory; and

  - d) report the results to the Director, in writing and in an electronic format acceptable to the Director, within 60 by of the samples being taken.

#### **Additional Reporting**

- 2. The Licencee shall, in addition to any of the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions specified in this Licence, upon the request of the Director:
  - a) sample, monitor, analyze or investigate specific areas of concern regarding any segment, component or aspect of pollutant storage, containment, treatment, handling, disposal or emission systems, for such pollutants or ambient quality, aquatic toxicity, leachate characteristics and discharge emission rates, for such duration and at such frequencies as may be specified;
  - b) determine the environmental impact associated with the release of any pollutants from the Development;
  - c) conduct specific investigations in response to the data gathered during environmental monitoring programs; or

d) provide the Director, within such time as may be specified, with such reports, drawings, specifications, analytical data, flow rate measurements and such other information as may from time to time be requested.

#### **Reporting Format**

3. The Licencee shall submit all information required to be provided to the Director or Environment Officer under this Licence, in written and electronic format, in such form (including number of copies) and of such content as may be required by the Director or Environment Officer, and each submission shall be clearly labeled with the Licence Number and Client File Number associated with this Licence.

#### Odour

4. The Licencee shall not cause or permit an odour nuisance to be created as result of the construction, operation or alteration of the Development, and shall take such step as ne Director may require to eliminate or mitigate an odour nuisance.

#### Noise

5. The Licencee shall not cause or permit a noise pass cell be created as a result of the construction, operation or alteration of the Development, and shall take such steps as the Director may require to eliminate or mitigate a noise nuisance.

#### SPECIFICATIONS LIMITS AND CONDITIONS

#### **Additional Permits**

6. The Licencee shall obtain a specificary municipal, provincial and federal permits and approvals for construction of relevant appropriate of the Development prior to commencement of construction.

#### Maintenance

7. The Licencee shall, at all times during the operation of the Development, implement a high standard of equipment maintenance and operational practices.

### Recycling

8. The Licencee shall reduce the production and dissemination of wastes by initiating and maintaining waste reduction and waste recycling programs.

#### **Environmental Accident Reporting**

9. The Licencee shall, in the case of physical or mechanical equipment breakdown or process upset where such breakdown or process upset results or may result in the release of a pollutant in an amount or concentration, or at a level or rate of release, that causes or may cause a significant adverse effect, immediately report the event by calling the 24-hour environmental accident reporting line at (204)

944-4888 (toll-free 1-855-944-4888). The report shall indicate the nature of the event, the time and estimated duration of the event and the reason for the event.

- 10. The Licencee shall, following the reporting of an event pursuant to Clause 9,
  - a) identify the repairs required to the mechanical equipment;
  - b) undertake all repairs to minimize unauthorized discharges of a pollutant;
  - c) complete the repairs in accordance with any written instructions of the Director; and
  - d) submit a report to the Director about the causes of breakdown and measures taken, within one week of the repairs being done.

#### **Liquid Fertilizers**

- 11. The Licencee shall surface, grade, dyke, and/or curb all areas where tiquid fertilizer is stored, loaded, blended, transferred or otherwise handled with concrete or in a many and using materials approved by the Director, such that all product spillage and contaminated un-on water from these areas is contained.
- 12. The Licencee shall provide containment within any curb of living for tilizer tank farm storage area for a volume of liquid equal to 110% of the volume of the argest storage tank located therein.
- 13. The Licencee shall maintain the containment area plunt capacity of Clause 12 of this Licence by the immediate removal and disposal, in a mouner a proved by an Environment Officer, of all accumulated fluids.

#### Granular Fertilizer

14. The Licencee shall surface, grace and/or curb all areas where granular fertilizer is stored, loaded, blended, transferred therwise handled with concrete or in a manner and using materials approved by the Director, ucb that all product spillage and contaminated run-off water from these areas is contained.

#### **Pest Control Products**

- 15. The Licencee shall meet or exceed the current guidelines for Agrichemical Warehousing Standards Association (AWSA) certification regarding the handling and storage of pest control products.
- 16. The Licencee shall design and construct the secondary containment area for agrichemical warehouses such that it is protected with a minimum of 45 centimetres of compacted clay material or other materials approved by the Director.
- 17. The Licencee shall inspect the surface of the secondary containment area semiannually for desiccation cracks, so that the secondary containment area's continuity is maintained.
- 18. The Licencee shall construct and maintain concrete floors with a minimum 10 centimetres retention curbing around the perimeter of all agrichemical warehouses so as to prevent spilled liquids from leaking into the soil.

- 19. The Licencee shall install and maintain, for all agrichemical warehouses, an automatic system for fire detection and security.
- 20. The Licencee shall create and maintain current duplicate inventories of all pest control products stored at the Development, with one copy stored at the premises of the Development, and the other copy stored at a location off-site from the Development.
- 21. The Licencee shall store only pest control products registered under the federal Pest Control Products *Act* at the Development.
- 22. The Licencee shall not mix pest control products or fill or re-fill pest control product containers at the Development.
- 23. The Licencee shall locate pest control products storage structures a mi um distance of:
  - a) 100 metres from any property zoned residential; and
  - b) 100 metres from single residences

unless a written consent form is obtained from the owner(s) and proved by the Director.

#### **Chemical Storage and Spill Containment**

- 24. The Licencee shall ensure fuel storage containers me roo secondary containment satisfactory to an Environment Officer.
- 25. The Licencee shall comply with all the ar pircable requirements of:
  - Manitoba Regulation 188/2001t Storage and Handling of Petroleum Products and Allied
  - Products, or any future ame tament the cof;

    The Dangerous Goods Hould by and Transportation Act, and regulations issued thereunder, respecting the handling, ransport, storage and disposal of any dangerous goods brought onto or generated at the Divelopment; and the Office of the are compassioner – Province of Manitoba.
  - c)
- 26. The Licencee shall provid containment for all vessels containing chemicals in each area of the Development where the chemicals are stored, loaded, transferred, used or otherwise handled, in · compliance with the National Fire Code of Canada (2010), or any future amendment thereof, such that any product leakage or spillage and any contaminated liquid generated is contained within the Development and contamination of groundwater is prevented.
- 27. The Licencee shall, in a manner approved by the Director, remove and dispose of all spilled dangerous goods.

#### **Liquid Emissions**

28. The Licencee shall document all releases, spills, leaks or discharges of chemicals that occur within the Development in an incident log. The incident log shall document at a minimum the date, time, chemical, estimated volume and the clean up actions taken for each release, spill, leak or discharge. The incident log shall be updated within 24 hours of an incident occurrence and be made available at the request of an Environment Officer or Director.

- 29. The Licencee shall only remove or permit removal of storm water or surface water that has accumulated in the secondary containment area if there have been no documented releases, spills, leaks or discharges of chemicals (from the previous removal to the current). In the event a documented incident has occurred, the Licencee must receive authorization from a designated Environment Officer or Director prior to removal of any accumulated liquid. If any accumulated liquid may be contaminated, it shall be sampled and tested for appropriate parameters by an accredited laboratory prior to any request for removal.
- 30. The Licencee shall not direct any spillage, contaminated run-off or pollutant, other than wastewater, to an approved wastewater disposal system.
- 31. The Licencee shall contain and clean up immediately any pest control product or chemical spills in order to prevent soil, surface water or ground water contamination.
- 32. The Licencee shall remediate, within a time frame stipulated by the Director, all on and off-site environmental impacts as a result of any release of a chemical.

#### **LLDPE/HDPE Liners**

- 33. The Licencee shall construct and maintain a containment area or liquid fertilizer vessels such that:
  - a) the containment area is constructed of concret of materials as approved by the Director and is joined to a impermeable, continuous her in a manner capable of preventing infiltration at the base of the interface;
  - b) the liner is constructed from LLD E-HD. E geomembrane;
  - c) all sections of the liner are joined by do ble channel fusion seaming;
  - d) in accordance with ASTM Standard 19-4437, the integrity of all field seams are tested by non-destructive test methods are ting report is prepared and submitted to the Director within 30 days of commencing he installation of the liner; and
  - e) the liner has a minin up mickness of 30 mils.
- 34. The Licencee shall notice the assigned Environment Officer one week prior to commencing the installation of the liner underlying the liquid fertilizer containment area of the Development.
- 35. The Licencee shall cover all surfaces of the liner underlying the liquid fertilizer containment area of the Development with 0.3 metres of cover material.
- 36. The Licencee shall not cover the liner underlying the liquid fertilizer containment area of the Development until receiving approval of the assigned Environment Officer.

#### **Emergency Response Planning**

37. The Licencee shall prepare and maintain an emergency response contingency plan in accordance with the Canadian Centre for Occupational Health and Safety "Emergency Response Planning Guide" or other emergency planning document acceptable to the Director.

#### **Closure and Post Closure**

- 38. The Licencee shall submit, for the approval of the Director, a formal detailed closure and post closure plan for the Development not less than one year prior to the closure of the Development.
- 39. The Licencee shall implement and maintain the approved closure and post closure plan.

#### **REVIEW AND REVOCATION**

- A. If construction of the Development is not commenced within three years of the date of this Licence, the Licence is revoked.
- B. If, in the opinion of the Director, the Licencee has exceeded or is reeding or has or is failing to meet the specifications, limits, terms, or conditions set out in this licence, the Director may, temporarily or permanently, revoke this Licence.
- C. If, in the opinion of the Director, new evidence warrants, charge if the specifications, limits, terms, or conditions of this Licence, the Director may require the immg of a new proposal pursuant to Section 10 of *The Environment Act*.
