

Notice of Environment Act Proposal

Manitoba Sustainable Development has received a proposal pursuant to *The Environment Act* regarding the following operation and invites public participation in the review process:

SOUTHLAND CHURCH INC. - BIRD RIVER BIBLE CAMP ONSITE WASTEWATER MANAGEMENT SYSTEM – FILE: 5866.00

A proposal was filed on behalf of Southland Church Inc., Steinbach for the construction and operation of an onsite wastewater management system that will serve the Bird River Bible Camp which operates on a seasonal basis at NE01-17-13EPM in the Rural Municipality of Alexander. Wastewater effluent will be disposed of onsite through the use of appurtenances such as a kitchen grease trap, solids holding tanks, distribution line and valve chamber and a septic field. Periodic removal of solids from septic tanks will be by registered sewage haulers who will take the solids to licenced or permitted disposal facilities. Currently existing on-site holding tanks will be decommissioned upon successful commissioning of the new system.
