

Notice of Environment Act Proposal

Manitoba Sustainable Development has received a proposal pursuant to The Environment Act regarding the following operation and invites public participation in the review process:

Controlled Environments Ltd. – Conviron Facility – FILE NO. 5870.00

An Environment Act Proposal was filed by Controlled Environments Ltd. (Conviron) for the continued operation of a controlled environment system manufacturing facility at 580 and 590 Berry Street in Winnipeg, Manitoba. The facility designs, manufactures, and installs plant growth chambers and rooms, and high performance research greenhouses to markets such as agricultural biotechnology and other life-science disciplines. The potential environmental effects of the development are air emission and generation of solid waste.
