The treated effluent will be discharged into the Glen Lea Golf Course reservoirs for irrigation purposes and any excess treated effluent will be discharged into Willow Creek through a natural drainage ditch and a roadside ditch, and eventually into the Assiniboine River. The existing lagoon servicing Meadowbrook Village will be decommissioned.
