

Notice of Environment Act Proposal

Manitoba Sustainable Development has received an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) pursuant to The Environment Act from the following operation and invites public participation in the review process:

**MANITOBA INFRASTRUCTURE - PROJECT 6 – ALL-SEASON ROAD LINKING
MANTO SIPI CREE NATION, BUNIBONIBEE CREE NATION AND GOD’S LAKE
FIRST NATION FILE: 5897.00**

Manitoba Infrastructure has filed an EIS for Project 6, an all-season road linking Manto Sipi Cree Nation, Bunibonibee Cree Nation, and God’s Lake First Nation. The project involves construction of a new 138 km all-season road on provincial Crown land and includes two major water crossing over God’s River and Magill Creek.
