
A Dangerous Goods Handling and Transportation Act Application has been filed by Stericycle ULC for the operation of a medical waste and hazardous waste transfer facility at 20 Ronn Road, Stony Mountain, RM of Rosser, Manitoba. The facility is to be located within the commercial area of the Inland Port Special Zoning area. The proposed facility will accept medical waste, hazardous and non-hazardous wastes to be consolidated, stored temporarily and then transferred to other licensed facilities for disposal or processing.
