SUBJECT: Comments on DGH & T Proposal Additional information – Rakowski Recycling – Waste Batteries Collection Facility (File No.5972.00)

Manitoba Sustainable Development, Winnipeg Regional Office of Environmental Compliance and Enforcement Branch has reviewed the above noted Additional Information provided regarding the Dangerous Goods Handling & Transportation Act Licence proposal for the operation at 454 Archibald Street, Winnipeg, and has the following comments to provide:

1. The proposed storage site for the batteries is a steel shipping container with ventilation. Is the ventilation going to be passive or mechanical? If it is holding a full inventory of batteries (60,000 lbs as per proposal), will passive ventilation be sufficient for that volume of material?
