Transfer Station Operating Permit

Following the Waste Management Facilities Regulation under The Environment Act, Rural Municipality of Rockwood is hereby permitted to run the Winfield Road Transfer Station on portions of NE 19-13-02 EPM within the Rural Municipality of Rockwood, Manitoba. Schedule A of this permit identifies the facility.

This permit is subject to being amended, suspended, or revoked under sections 7 and 9 of the Waste Management Facilities Regulation.

General Terms and Operating Conditions

1. This permit expires on March 08, 2029.
2. The operator must maintain and operate the facility following the Waste Management Facilities Regulation and any future amendments and this permit.
3. The operator must obtain approval in writing from the director before altering the facility.

Materials Acceptance and Handling

4. The operator must segregate materials collected for recycling or reuse, and must temporarily stockpile these materials in designated areas with clear signage. The operator must maintain these areas to control weeds, vectors, and the quality of the materials.
5. The operator must remove all materials received at the facility regularly or upon the request of an environment officer, within the timeframe specified.
6. The operator must implement control measures to prevent the attraction and sustenance of rodents and scavenging vectors.
7. The operator must not accept any livestock or other animal mortalities at the facility.

Hazardous Wastes

8. The operator must collect and dispose of any hazardous waste following The Dangerous Goods Handling and Transportation Act, and other federal, provincial, and municipal regulations.

Surface Water Management

9. The operator must construct the facility such that all uncontaminated surface water flows to the perimeter ditch and impacted water from all material storage areas is contained within the facility boundaries.

Burning of Specified Waste

10. The operator must only burn:
 - a) separated and readily combustible materials such as boughs, leaves, loose straw, paper products, cardboard, non-salvageable untreated wood, and packing materials derived from wood; and
 - b) only when there is an appropriate volume of materials as identified in clause 10 (a) of this permit.

Composting

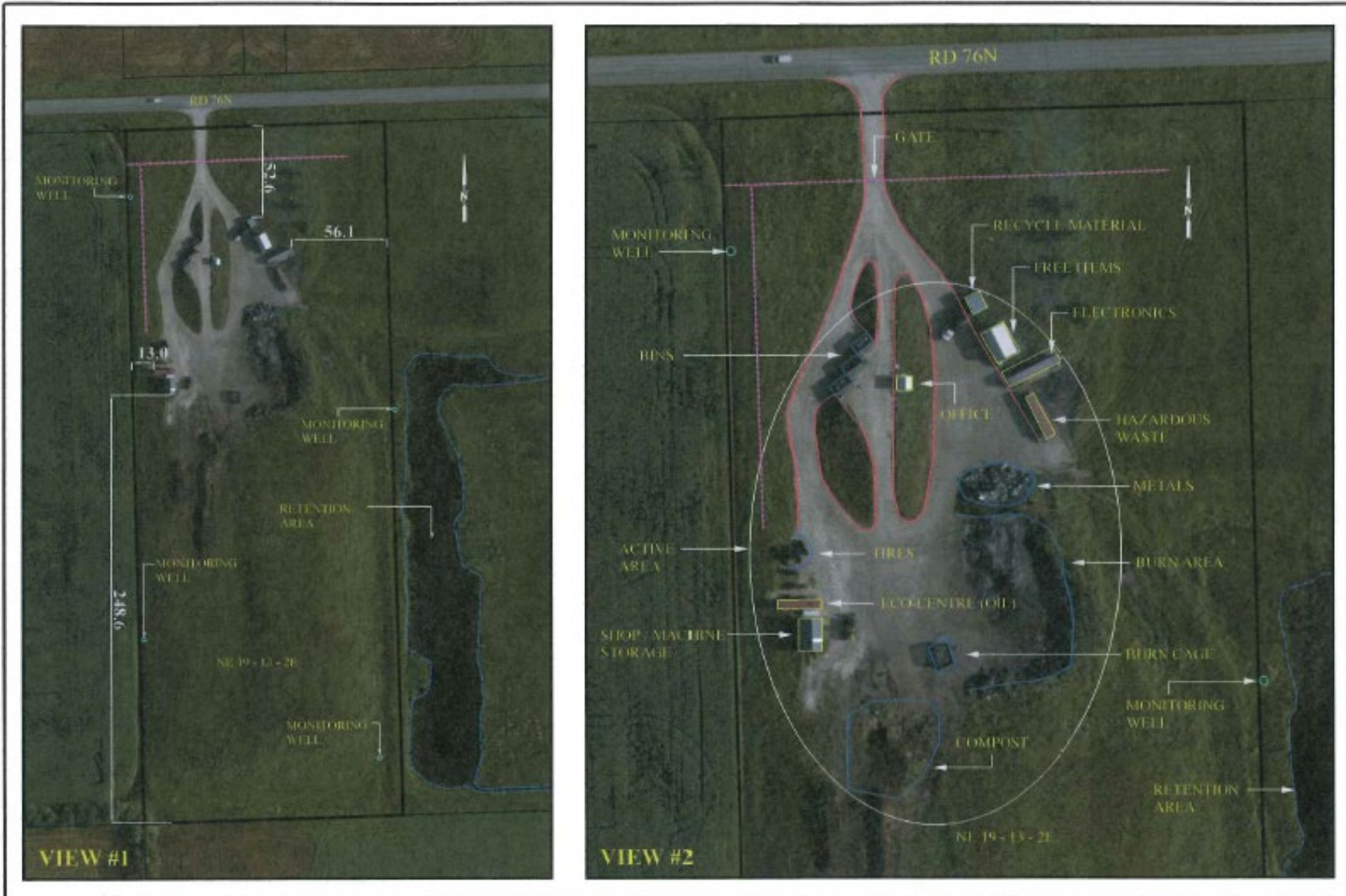
11. The operator must, unless otherwise approved by an environment officer, compost only yard and leaf waste.

Revocation

12. This permit replaces Permit No. 40503 P1, which is expired.
