In accordance with the Waste Management Facilities Regulation, made under The Environment Act, Parks and Protected Spaces, Conservation and Climate, is hereby permitted to operate the Moose Lake Transfer Station located on portions of SW 7-3-17 EPM within the Crown Land Unorganized Territory, Province of Manitoba.

THIS PERMIT is subject to being AMENDED, SUSPENDED or REVOKED under sections 7 and 9 of the Waste Management Facilities Regulation.

THIS PERMIT is issued subject to the following TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

General Terms and Operating Conditions

- 1. This permit expires on December 1, 2026.
- 2. The Operator shall maintain and operate the Moose Lake Transfer Station (the Facility) as identified in Schedule A of this permit in accordance with the Waste Management Facilities Regulation and any future amendments thereto, and this Permit.
- 3. The Operator shall maintain a copy of the Operations Manual developed in accordance with the Waste Management Facilities Regulation and any future amendments thereto, and a copy of this Permit at the Facility or where the Facility is managed.
- 4. The Operator shall obtain approval in writing from the Director of Environmental Approvals Branch for any proposed alterations to the Facility before proceeding with the alteration.

Site Access and Control

5. The Operator shall restrict access to the Facility when site supervision is not provided, with a locked gate, barrier or other system approved in writing by an Environment Officer.

Materials Acceptance and Handling

- 6. Unless otherwise approved in writing by the Director of Environmental Compliance and Enforcement, the Operator shall only accept at the Facility the solid waste generated within the two provincial campgrounds and cottages in the Moose Lake area.
- 7. The Operator shall segregate materials collected for recycling or reuse, and shall temporarily stockpile these materials in clearly signed designated areas. These areas must be maintained to control weeds, vectors, and quality of the materials.
- 8. The Operator shall remove the materials identified in clause 7 of this Permit regularly or upon the request of an Environment Officer, within the timeframe specified.
- 9. The Operator shall remove any litter accumulated along the access road and around the perimeter of the site. Litter collection shall occur at minimum twice annually or as required by an Environment Officer.
- 10. The Operator shall not bury or permanently dispose of any materials at the transfer station without obtaining any written authorization from an Environment Officer.

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- 11. The Operator shall remove the household waste deposited at the Facility at minimum every thirty (30) days or at a frequency required by an Environment Officer.
- 12. The Operator shall implement control measures to prevent attraction and sustenance of rodents and scavenging vectors.
- 13. The Operator shall not accept any livestock or other animal mortalities at the Facility.

Solid Waste

14. The Operator shall dispose of all non-hazardous solid waste collected at the Facility, which is not recycled, only to a waste disposal ground operating under the authority of a permit issued pursuant to the Waste Management Facilities Regulation or any future amendment thereof, or a licence issued pursuant to The Environment Act.

Hazardous Wastes

15. The Operator shall collect and dispose of hazardous waste in accordance with The Dangerous Goods Handling and Transportation Act, and other Provincial and Federal Regulations.

Surface Water Management

16. The Operator shall construct the Facility such that all uncontaminated surface water flows to the perimeter ditch and impacted water from all material storage areas is contained within the Facility boundaries.

Burning of Specified Waste

- 17. The Operator shall obtain a Permit to Burn as required under The Wildfires Act prior to igniting any fires at the Facility.
- 18. The Operator shall only burn separated and readily combustible materials such as boughs, leaves, loose straw, paper products, cardboard, non-salvageable untreated wood, and packing materials derived from wood, and only when there is an appropriate volume of this material.
- 19. The Operator shall not burn, other than those materials specified in clause 18 of this Permit, any other products or materials, including but not limited to plywood, composite board or other materials constructed with glues, finishes or preservatives, plastics, composites, rubber, manure, chemically treated fabrics, mattresses, finished furniture, or synthetics.

Composting

20. The Operator shall compost only yard and leaf waste.

Revocation

21. This Permit replaces Permit No. 46578 which is hereby rescinded.
