# Transfer Station Operating Permit

**File No. : 47013**

**Permit No.: 65072**

**Issue Date: December 23, 2022**

Following the Waste Management Facilities Regulation under The Environment Act, Manitoba Hydro is hereby permitted to run the Kelsey Generating Station Waste Transfer Station (facility) located on portions of SW 19-81-7 EPM within the Unorganized Territory, Province of Manitoba. Schedule A of this permit identifies the facility.

This permit is subject to being amended, suspended, or revoked under sections 7 and 9 of the Waste Management Facilities Regulation.

This permit is issued subject to the following terms and conditions:

## **General Terms and Operating Conditions**

1. This permit expires on December 21, 2027.
2. The operator must maintain and operate the facility following the Waste Management Facilities Regulation and any future amendments thereof, and this permit.
3. The operator must obtain approval in writing from the director before altering the facility.

## **Materials Acceptance and Handling**

4. The operator must segregate materials collected for recycling or reuse, and must temporarily stockpile these materials in clearly signed designated areas. These areas must also be maintained to control weeds, vectors, and the quality of the materials.
5. The operator must remove all materials received at the facility regularly or upon the request of an environment officer, within the timeframe specified.
6. The operator must implement control measures to prevent the attraction and sustenance of rodents and scavenging vectors.
7. The operator must not accept any livestock or other animal mortalities at the facility.

## **Surface Water Management**

8. The operator must construct the facility such that all uncontaminated surface water flows to the perimeter ditch and impacted water from all material storage areas is contained within the facility boundaries.

**Burning of Specified Waste**

9. The operator must only burn:
  - a) separated and readily combustible materials such as boughs, leaves, loose straw, paper products, cardboard, non-salvageable untreated wood, and packing materials derived from wood; and
  - b) only when there is an appropriate volume of materials as identified in clause 9(a).

**Composting**

10. The operator must not allow composting at the facility.
