Material Recovery Facility Operating Permit

Following the Waste Management Facilities Regulation under The Environment Act, Cascades Recovery+ is hereby permitted to run the Cascades Recovery+ Material Recovery Facility (facility) located at 100 Omands Creek Blvd. within the City of Winnipeg. Schedule A of this permit identifies the facility.

This permit is subject to being amended, suspended or revoked under sections 7 and 9 of the Waste Management Facilities Regulation.

Definitions

In this permit,

"director" means an employee so designated following The Environment Act.

"noise nuisance" means an unwanted sound, in an affected area, which is annoying, troublesome, or disagreeable to a person:

- a) residing in an affected area;
- b) working in an affected area; or
- c) present at a location in an affected area which is normally open to members of the public;

if the unwanted sound

- d) is the subject of at least five written complaints, received by the director in a form satisfactory to the director and within a 90-day period, from five different persons falling within clauses a), b) or c), who do not live in the same household; or
- e) is the subject of at least one written complaint, received by the director in a form satisfactory to the director, from a person falling within clauses a), b) or c) and the director is of the opinion that if the unwanted sound had occurred in a more densely populated area there would have been at least five written complaints received within a 90-day period, from five different persons who do not live in the same household;

"odour nuisance" means a continuous or repeated odour, smell or aroma, in an affected area, which is offensive, obnoxious, troublesome, annoying, unpleasant or disagreeable to a person:

- a) residing in an affected area;
- b) working in an affected area; or
- c) present at a location in an affected area which is normally open to members of the public;

if the odour, smell or aroma

- d) is the subject of at least five written complaints, received by the director in a form satisfactory to the director and within a 90-day period, from five different persons falling within clauses (a), (b) or (c), who do not live in the same household; or
- e) is the subject of at least one written complaint, received by the director in a form satisfactory to the director, from a person falling within clauses (a), (b) or (c) and the director is of the opinion that if the odour, smell or aroma had occurred in a more densely populated area there would have been at least five written complaints received within a 90-day period, from 5 different persons who do not live in the same household.

This permit is issued subject to the following terms and conditions:

General Terms and Operating Conditions

- 1. This permit expires on December 21, 2027.
- 2. The operator must maintain and operate the facility following the Waste Management Facilities Regulation and any future amendments thereof, and this permit.
- 3. The operator must obtain approval in writing from the director before altering the facility.

Responsible Party

- 4. The operator must, within 60 days of the date of issuance of this permit, designate an employee as the facilities environmental coordinator, whose job description will include assisting:
 - a) the operator in complying with the limits, terms and conditions in this permit,
 - b) senior management to manage environmental issues at the facility.
- 5. The name of the environmental coordinator must be submitted in writing to the director within 14 days of the appointment and any subsequent appointment.

Site Access and Control

6. The operator must provide site supervision when the public can access the processing area of the facility.

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Odour Nuisance

7. The operator must not cause or permit an odour nuisance to be created as a result of the construction, operation, or alteration of the facility, and must take such steps as the director may specify to eliminate or mitigate an odour nuisance.

Noise Nuisance

8. The operator must not cause or permit a noise nuisance to be created as a result of the operation or alteration of the facility, and must take such steps as the director may require to eliminate or mitigate a noise nuisance.

Materials Acceptance and Handling

- 9. The operator must segregate materials collected for recycling or reuse, and must temporarily stockpile these materials in clearly signed designated areas. These areas must also be maintained to control weeds, vectors, and the quality of the materials.
- The operator must remove the materials identified in clause 9 of this permit regularly or upon the request of an environment officer, within the timeframe specified.
- 11. The operator must not store any wastes, or materials separated out during processing that are not recycled or reused, except in appropriate storage bins in a manner to prevent nuisance.


Burning
