# Transfer Station Operating Permit

File No. : 87631

Issue Date: July 12, 2024

Following the Waste Management Facilities Regulation under The Environment Act, the Municipality of Clanwilliam-Erickson is hereby permitted to operate the Clanwilliam-Erickson Waste Transfer Station on portions of SW 32-17-18 WPM within the Municipality of Clanwilliam-Erickson, Manitoba. Schedule A of this permit identifies the facility. The transfer station is located within Erickson Landfill, which is now closed.

This permit is subject to being amended, suspended, or revoked under sections 7 and 9 of the Waste Management Facilities Regulation.

## **General Terms and Operating Conditions**

1. This permit expires on July 12, 2029.
2. The operator must maintain and operate the facility following the Waste Management Facilities Regulation and any future amendments and this permit.
3. The operator must develop an operations manual, within 12 months of the date of this permit, detailing the operation and maintenance of this facility following the Waste Management Facilities Regulation and any future amendments thereof. The operator must provide the manual to an environment officer upon request.
4. The operator must obtain approval in writing from the director before altering the facility.

## **Materials Acceptance and Handling**

5. The operator must:
  - a) segregate materials collected for recycling or reuse;
  - b) temporarily stockpile these materials in designated areas with clear signage; and
  - c) must maintain these areas to control weeds, vectors, and the quality of the materials.
6. The operator must remove all materials received at the facility regularly or upon the request of an environment officer, within the timeframe specified.
7. The operator must implement control measures to prevent the attraction and sustenance of rodents and scavenging vectors.
8. The operator must not accept any livestock or other animal mortalities at the facility.

## **Site Construction**

9. The operator must have the ramp and retaining wall of the waste transfer station, and any modifications, or alterations thereto designed by and construction overseen by an engineer.
10. The operator must construct the facility following the design plans submitted to the designated environment officer on June 3, 2024.
11. The operator must notify the designated environment officer at least 5 days and not more than 10 days before the commencement of construction of the transfer station.

12. The operator must:
- a) prepare record drawings of the facility and must label the drawings "record drawings"; and
  - b) submit "record drawings" along with construction reports to the designated environment officer within 120 days of the completion of construction of the facility.

**Surface Water Management**

13. The operator must construct the facility such that all uncontaminated surface water flows to the perimeter ditch and impacted water from all material storage areas is contained within the facility boundaries.

**Burning of Specified Waste**

14. The operator must only burn:
- a) separated and readily combustible materials such as boughs, leaves, loose straw, paper products, cardboard, non-salvageable untreated wood, and packing materials derived from wood; and
  - b) when there is an appropriate volume of materials as identified in clause 14 (a) of this permit.

**Composting**

15. The operator must, unless otherwise approved by an environment officer, compost only yard and leaf waste.

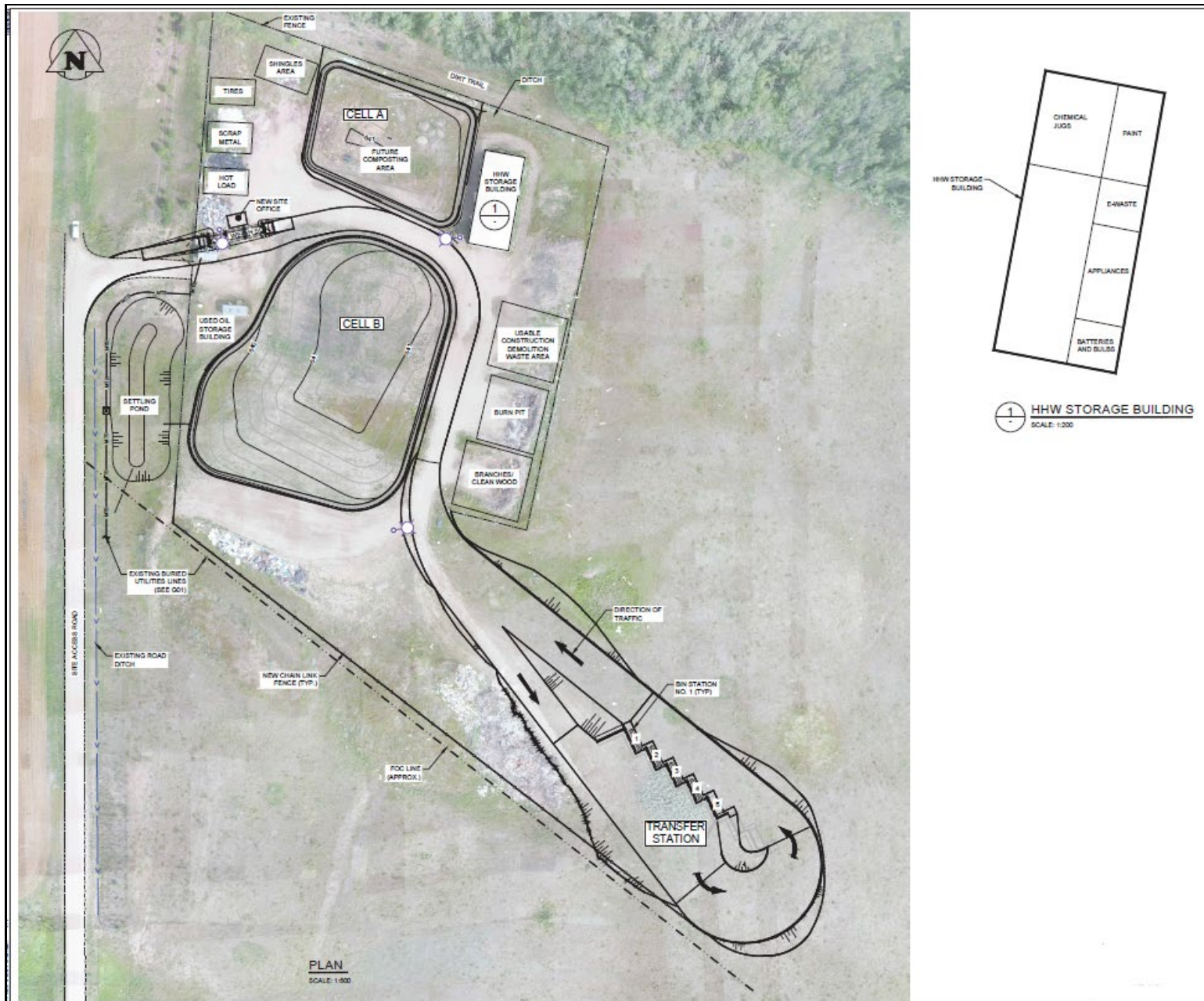


Figure 1: Clanwilliam-Erickson Waste Transfer Station Facility Layout
