My response to the Environmental Compliance and Enforcement comments are as follows:

1. See attached
2. The frequency of dust suppression will be on an as required basis, typically weekly, but weather dependant as dryer weather will require increase suppression. Recycled asphalt chippings have been placed on the entire site, prior to plant set up. This combined with our dust suppression measures will eliminate any dust issues. Conveyor belts are covered to eliminate dust emission. A fence has been installed as a barrier between adjacent properties.
3. Noise mitigations measures include a noise dampening encloser of the generators and bag house, a modern burner, and noise reducing baffles and insulation on the drying drum.
4. Baseline air emission sampling will occur upon completion of the initial set up and calibration of the plant. Sampling methodology will be in accordance with ASTM D7036-16 Standard Practice for Competence of Air Emission Testing Bodies.
5. Wintec understands a permit is required, and we are taking all required precautions and safety measures to ensure we comply with regulations.
6. Wintec is committed to maintain a positive relationship with all regulators, stakeholders, and the public. Specific concerns will be addressed urgently if they arise. Wintec's proposed plant is considerably smaller than others in the area, much newer and due to extensive mitigation measures outlined in the EAP and above, will not have an impact on the surrounding area outside of the Mission Industrial area.
