We are legal counsel to CanWhite Sands Corp. ("CanWhite"). Please accept this letter as a submission for the public record concerning our client's environmental license application, currently under review.

We have been provided with a screenshot of a notice of meeting being organized by Our Line in the Sand and What the Frack Manitoba (the "Groups"), which is attached for your ease of reference (the "Notice").

As part of the notice, the Groups use the logo of CanWhite and proprietary artwork developed for use on our client's materials filed in regulatory applications.

We note as follows:

1. The CanWhite logo and the proprietary artwork are being used by the Groups without the knowledge or consent of CanWhite or AECOM, the consultant who prepared the artwork for use on CanWhite application material.



2. To be clear, this meeting is occurring without the involvement of CanWhite. Our client was not invited to participate in the Groups' meeting.
3. As you may know, in accordance with your request, last week CanWhite held a public meeting to provide the public with accurate information about its project.
 - a. As you requested of our client, an outside facilitator was retained to organize and moderate the meeting. The meeting was recorded. Our client is preparing a report of the meeting and hopes to provide it to you by December 23, 2020. Our client's report will include input from the facilitator as well. In CanWhite's view, the meeting went well and addressed the concerns raised.
 - b. Our client advises that the facilitator invited representatives from the Groups to attend the CanWhite public meeting but these representatives refused to attend and encouraged people on social media not to attend our meeting. Our client has instructed the facilitator to include material relevant to this issue in her report.

CanWhite has been and continues to be open to meeting with anyone who may have concerns about their projects, particularly residents of the communities involved.

In our client's experience, the Groups have asserted things that are not factually accurate. If you receive additional comments, questions or concerns resulting from the Groups' December 19 meeting, our client will, of course, be pleased to provide you with information in reply.
