SUBJECT: Environmental Act Proposal (6059)

Concerns.

The Archaeological Assessment Services Unit (AASU) has heritage concerns regarding the construction of the 2.6 km concentrate water pipeline. The current proposed route outlined on page 38 of the EAP is unclear due to the scale of the map, therefore, it is not possible to assess the footprint of the development and where the discharge point is to be situated along the river. There are numerous sites along the river in the area, which has high potential for heritage resources.

We request that a detailed footprint/development plan (including any temporary work spaces) be forwarded to the AASU so that it may conduct a review of the proposed development against heritage resources. As the current plans stand, the AASU is requesting a heritage resource impact assessment (HRIA) for the proposed pipeline. We do not have concerns regarding the construction of the proposed well sites.

Under Section 12(2) of The Heritage Resources Act, if there is reason to believe that heritage resources or human remains are known, or thought likely to be present, on lands that are to be developed, then the owner/developer is required to conduct at his/her own expense, a heritage resource impact assessment (HRIA) and mitigation, if necessary, prior to the project's start.

The developer must contract a qualified archaeological consultant to conduct a Heritage Resources Impact assessment (HRIA) of the proposed development location, in order to identify and assess any heritage resources that may be negatively impacted by development. The Branch can work with the developer/land owners and its consultant to draw up terms of reference for this project.
