Hi Edwin,

I have reviewed the application (File: 6098) and noted the following:

- Both the DGHTA application and the hazardous waste registration form are **not signed** by the proponent. **Can you email these to me so I can sign them?**
- Site diagram indicates the location of storage of different waste materials. It is not clear if those are covered structures or open storage. **Most items are open storage except for the Eco Centre, paint cans and florescent lights are stored in tubs provided by Product Care. Again if you can email me the diagram, I can add what is covered and what is open storage.**
- If the site marked “Eco centre” is for the storage of used oil, used oil filters and empty containers, information related to loading/unloading of used oil, capacity of the storage tank/ double/single walled/ spill containment measures etc. are need to be provided. **The Eco Centre building is 10 x 24 with a 4500L single walled tank with containment beneath the grates.**
- There are currently two records for SE 29-26-28 W, Lot 1, Plan 31679 (Roblin/ RM of Shell River) exist in our system. These is one with the DGHTA licence 278 HW File:5743.00 – cancelled on March 4, 2019. But operating as Shell River-Hillsburg Eco Centre used oil collection facility. Another one is with HW registration only (no licence issued), operating as Roblin Waste Disposal Site. As the new application has to be merged with one of the existing records, the proponent has to indicate the most relevant one. **Prior to the municipal amalgamation, the RM of Shell River requested to relocate the Eco Centre from Lot 1 Plan 1944 (NW 4-26-28) to the Roblin/Shell River WDS at Lot 1 Plan 31679 (SE 29-26-28). Since the amalgamation, the RM of Shell River no longer exists so the most relevant one would be the latter, now operating as Roblin Waste Disposal Site.**
