OVERVIEW

Manitoba Conservation and Climate received a Proposal on March 3, 2021, and additional information on May 28, 2021 for the operation of a household hazardous waste collection, storage and transfer depot (the Facility) located at the Roblin Waste Disposal Ground, Lot 1 Plan 31679, SE 29-26-28 WPM, in the Municipality of Roblin. The Facility accepts and stores hazardous and non-hazardous wastes including aerosols, automotive antifreeze, batteries, compressed gases, fluorescent lighting tubes and compact fluorescent lights, paint products, used oil, and used oil filters & used oil containers. The hazardous wastes are transported from this Facility to a licensed facility for further processing, reuse or disposal. No hazardous waste is disposed of at this location.

The Department, on March 31, 2021, placed copies of the Proposal in the Public Registries located online at https://www.gov.mb.ca/sd/eal/registries/6098/6098.00_application.pdf. Copies of the Proposal were also provided to the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) members. A notice of The Dangerous Goods Handling and Transportation Act proposal was placed in the Roblin Review on April 6, 2021. The newspaper and TAC notifications invited responses until May 6, 2021.

COMMENTS FROM THE TECHNICAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Manitoba Conservation and Climate – Environmental Compliance and Enforcement

- The Environmental Compliance and Enforcement Branch requires the following;
 - Signed application and hazardous waste registration forms
 - A site plan diagram with clearly marked locations of different hazardous wastes.
 - Confirmation if structures for different waste material are covered or not.
 - Information related to loading/unloading of used oil, capacity of the storage tank, type of tank (single wall or double wall), spill containment measures are to be provided.
 - Most relevant hazardous waste registration. There are currently two hazardous waste registration records for SE 29-26-28 W, Lot 1, Plan 31679 (Roblin/ RM of Shell River) exist in our system. There is one with the DGHTA Licence 278 HW (File No.5743.00), operating as Shell River-Hillsburg Eco Centre used oil collection facility. This licence was cancelled on March 4, 2019. Another one is with hazardous waste registration only operating as Roblin Waste Disposal Site with no licence. Information on both registrations will be merged into one.

Disposition:

The proponent submitted the additional information on May 28, 2021. The responses were shared with Environmental Compliance and Enforcement and no further comments were received.

PUBLIC HEARING

Because no public comments were received, a public hearing is not recommended.

CROWN-INDIGENOUS CONSULTATION

The Government of Manitoba recognizes that it has a duty to consult in a meaningful way with Indigenous communities when any proposed provincial law, regulation, decision or action may infringe upon or adversely affect the exercise of the Indigenous rights of that community.

This project is located on a property owned and operated by the applicant and located within an established and operating waste disposal ground known as Roblin Waste Disposal Ground in the Municipality of Roblin. All surrounding land potentially affected is privately owned. The project will not affect resources available for use on land or water. Since resource use would not be affected, there would be no infringement of Indigenous

rights under Section 35 of The Constitution Act, 1982. Therefore, it is concluded that Crown-Indigenous consultation is not required for the project.

RECOMMENDATION

The provincial Technical Advisory Committee expressed no concerns, or concerns are addressed in the draft licence, regarding the proposal. The Proponent should be issued a Licence for the operation of a household hazardous waste collection, storage and transfer depot in accordance with the specifications, limits, terms and conditions of the attached draft Licence. Enforcement of the Licence should be assigned to the Western Region of Environmental Compliance and Enforcement Branch of Manitoba Conservation and Climate.
