SUBJECT: Environment Act Proposal – Design and Construction of Interchange at PTH 100 and PR 200 (St. Mary’s Road) in the City of Winnipeg (File no. 6101.00)


Dear Ms. Dagdick,

As part of the Environment Act Proposal for the Design and Construction of an Interchange at PTH 100 and PR 200 (St. Mary’s Road), Manitoba Infrastructure (MI) had committed to building a sound attenuation barrier in order to mitigate potential increases in noise levels for adjacent residential areas.

Additional noise studies will be conducted after Project construction is completed in order to determine if a sound attenuation barrier is necessary. The City of Winnipeg Noise Guidelines adopted for this Project indicate that outside sound level limits for residential areas adjacent to a regional transportation facility is 65 dBA Ldn. A sound attenuation barrier or similar measures will be incorporated into the Project should subsequent studies support the need.
