- Site diagram
Site diagram indicates the location of hazardous waste storage areas - but not clear if those are covered structures or open storage.
- The following details are required:
 - Used oil storage tank: Above ground or underground, capacity, double or single walled, location of truck parking pad (for unloading used oil), spill containment measures, details of spill cleanup equipment and supplies etc.
 - Used oil filters and empty containers: Identify the storage location and indicate the type of containers used for the storage of these materials.
- Waste pesticides: Please identify the storage location

Further to your e-mail regarding the above noted hazardous waste depot, the Manitoba Historic Resources Branch has examined the location in conjunction with Branch records for areas of potential heritage concern. No further action is required for the current hazardous waste depot.

Archaeological sites, including human burials have been reported near this depot. These factors suggest that any future planned development within the area has the potential to impact heritage resources; therefore, the Historic Resources Branch has concerns if there are future expansion plans.

Under Section 12(2) of *The Heritage Resources Act*, if the Minister of Sport, Culture and Heritage has reason to believe that heritage resources or human remains are known, or thought likely to be present, on lands that are to be developed, then the owner/developer is required to conduct at his/her own expense, a heritage resource impact assessment (HRIA) and mitigation, if necessary, prior to the project's start.

The developer(s) must contract a qualified archaeological consultant to conduct a Heritage Resources Impact assessment (HRIA) of the proposed development location(s), in order to identify and assess any heritage resources that may be negatively impacted by development. If desirable, the Branch will work with the developer/land owners and its consultant to draw up terms of reference for this project.
