Re: Abas Girls Inc. and Abas Girls Ranch - Environment Act Licence No. 3371 - Notice of Alteration Approval

Thank you for your notice of alteration dated July 17, 2025, and additional information recieved on August 15, 2025. The department understands you wish to relocate the location of the wastewater treatment lagoon 30 metres north of the previously approved location in the Rural Municipality of Rosser.

We acknowledge receipt of your correspondence dated August 29, 2025, indicating that construction of the wastewater treatment lagoon at the new location has commenced.

Please be advised that proceeding with construction prior to receiving written approval from the Director constitutes non-compliance with Section 14 of The Environment Act. This section requires proponents to submit a Notice of Alteration and obtain approval before initiating any changes that may affect the environmental impact of a licensed or proposed development. Failure to obtain the necessary approvals may result in enforcement action by Manitoba Environment and Climate Change.

Notwithstanding, I approve the alteration per Section 14(2) of The Environment Act. The licensee shall comply with all other applicable federal, provincial, and municipal regulations and by-laws. All clauses of the Environment Act Licence No. 3371 remain in effect.
