Thank you for the response and additional information as submitted attached to the email below.


Upon review of the response regarding the wetlands, it has been determined that the proponent should conduct a wetland assessment to inventory the presence of seasonal, semi-permanent and permanent wetlands on the property and provide an assessment report to the Drainage and Water Rights Licensing Branch for review. Semi-permanent and permanent wetlands are not eligible for compensation and must be avoided. Class 3 (seasonal) wetlands are eligible for drainage if compensation is provided and in receipt of a water control works licence from Drainage and Water Rights Licensing Branch.

Please arrange with the proponent to conduct the wetland assessment and submit to me the assessment report, which I will forward to Drainage and Water Rights Licensing Branch for review.
