Re: Tundra Oil & Gas Limited - North Solution Gas Gathering Flowline Project

Environment, Climate and Parks received public comments about your application for an Environment Act Licence for your pipeline proposal.

The comments focused on the accidental release and disposal of hydrogen sulfide gas from the operation of the project. A team of provincial technical experts also reviewed and commented on your application. The branch shared this information with you on February 4, 2022. Your responses to the public comments are satisfactory. The department has chosen not to recommend a Clean Environment Commission public hearing to the Minister of Environment, Climate and parks. This decision may be appealed to the Minister of Environment, Climate and Parks by June 19, 2022.
