

Notice of Environment Act Proposal

Manitoba Conservation and Climate has received a proposal pursuant to The Environment Act regarding the following operation and invites public participation in the review process:

TUNDRA OIL & GAS LIMITED – NORTH SOLUTION GAS GATHERING FLOWLINE PROJECT – FILE: 6135.00

An Environment Act Proposal has been filed by Tundra Oil & Gas Limited for the construction and operation of six new interconnected flowline segments totaling 46 km in length in the RMs of Wallace-Woodworth and Pipestone in the area between Kola, Cromer, and Sinclair, Manitoba. The flowlines will collect and transport unrefined solution natural gas from six existing battery facilities to a compressor terminal located northwest of Sinclair, Manitoba.
